King's Marshall Nabs El Dorado

Aligre Stable's King's Marshall joined the parade of 'Cinderella Club' champions Tuesday at Hollywood Park as he drove to a neck victory over First Balcony in the \$22,000 El Dorado Handicap before a crowd of 25,700 which was treated to a march of long-priced winners.

Scoring his first victory in this country since his importation by the King Brothers last fall, King's Marshall raced the mile and one-sixteenth in 1:14 3/5 to turn back six rivals for a \$25 payoff.

and just missed in a strong effort. Have Tux, J. K. Housels' 8-5 favorite, with Billy Shoemaker in the irons, narrowly went down on the first turn when he tried to "run out" and then recovered to finish third, four lengths back of the first two. Prince Blessed, Jamie Boy, Blank Check and Henrihan trailed.

King's Marshall paid \$25, \$9.40 and \$5 across the board. First Balcony paid \$9 and Have Tux paid \$3.40 to show.

JOCKEY Eddie Burns kept his membership card in the "Cinderella Club" in good standing by picking up the amount of King's Marshall when George Taniguchi came down with the flu and was taken off all of his mounts.

Burns, who last Saturday got the biggest break of his career and came through by piloting Dotted Swiss to victory in the \$162,100 Hollywood Gold Cup in true Cinderella form, brought King's Marshall through between horses in the stretch to overhaul the leaders and roll on his short but decisive margin of victory.

First Balcony, with Pete Moreno, forced the early pace, Thought, Sue III, Kentucky which was set by Henrihan, Doll and Ruwenzori.

A FINE FIELD of eight older horses and a band of seven top fillies and mares are spotlighted in the account of King's Marshall features on today's eight-race program.

Ying and Yang, a close up second in his last outing, and The Shoe held the \$8,500 Hawthorne Purse which goes as the seventh race. Others in this field are Swirling Abby, King's Canasta, Top Double, Monk's Hood, Fall Wind and Orient II.

Bitter Feud, with Shoemaker aboard, is the probable favorite in the distaff allowance race, the sixth on the card. She will be opposed by Tritoma, Sweet June, Solid Thought, Sue III, Kentucky which was set by Henrihan, Doll and Ruwenzori.

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The law firm of Ball, Hunt & Hart will be employed for another year as special counsel to the city by vote of the City Council Tuesday.

One vote, that of Andrew W. Baird, was cast against the motion to employ the attorneys. Baird sought to put a \$80,000 maximum on the contract, but could not get a second to his motion.

Council acted after Councilman Raymond C. Kealer presented a letter from the Board of Harbor Commissioners appraising the work of the firm in the past and urging re-employment of special counsel to handle tidelands and upland oil matters.

CITY ATTY. Gerald Desmond noted that a total of \$36,916.29 was paid out last year for special legal counsel. The city has two firms which have been doing special jobs O'Melveny & Meyer and Ball, Hunt & Hart.

The O'Melveny & Meyer firm of Los Angeles is continuing only on cases which it had pending at the time its contract with the city ended in 1953 when the firm of Ball, Hunt & Hart was employed.

The Los Angeles law firm was paid \$10,148.88 last year, Ball, Hunt & Hart last year received \$26,769.41, according to Desmond.

Under the contract with the Long Beach firm, a top fee of \$50 per hour is paid. The firm is paid by the hour only for work done. The contract would expire June 30, 1961, and will be broad enough so that the firm can be retained on special matters without the necessity of drawing new contracts if the occasion should arise.
